1. Team must be a member of the Iowa Barbeque Society in the current year
2. Compete in a minimum of four (4) KCBS sanctioned contests in Iowa.
3. Scores from the team's four best sanctioned contests will be combined at the end of the season to create the team's TOY score.
4. Scores are compiled by the Iowa Barbeque Society using official contest scoring information provided by the KCBS.
5. The team with the highest TOY score at the end of the season will be crowned the top BBQ team in Iowa!

## F.C. Parrish - Most Improved Team (MIT)

Every year the Iowa Barbeque Society crowns the most improved competition team in Iowa with the prestigious F.C. Parrish M.I.T. award. The award is presented to the winning team at the Annual Banquet held in January. The following summarizes the requirements and process for the M.I.T. competition.

1. Team must be a member of the Iowa Barbeque Society in the current year.
2. Have competed in a minimum of four (4) KCBS sanctioned contests in Iowa the previous year.
3. Compete in a minimum of four (4) KCBS sanctioned contests in Iowa in the current year.
4. Scores from the team's four best sanctioned contests will be combined at the end of the season to create the team's M.I.T. score.
5. Scores are compiled by the Iowa Barbeque Society using official contest scoring information provided by the KCBS.
6. The team with the highest differential score (current year TOY score minus previous year TOY score) at the end of the season will be crowned the M.I.T. award winner!

## IBS Rookie of the Year

Every year the Iowa Barbeque Society honors the best newest cook of the year with this award. The award is presented to the winning team at the Annual Banquet held in January. The following summarizes the requirements and process for Rookie of the Year.

1. Team must be a member of the Iowa Barbeque Society in the current year.
2. Compete in a minimum of four (4) KCBS sanctioned contests in Iowa.
3. To qualify as "Rookie" the team must **NOT** have ever won any awards at the IBS banquet and has **NEVER** cooked more than 4 sanctioned contests in any state.
4. Scores from the team's four best sanctioned contests will be combined at the end of the season to create the team's Rookie TOY score.
5. Scores are compiled by the Iowa Barbeque Society using official contest scoring information provided by the KCBS.
6. The Rookie team with the highest TOY score at the end of the season will be crowned Iowa Rookie team of the year!
