Bordenaro's Backyard BBQ Bash General Information

Cook Site

Cook sites are assigned by the contest organizers. Organizer will direct you to assigned space when you arrive. Entry to the cook area on Adams street to the north off of HWY 30. Organizer will be onsite at 6:30 to allow teams in. Site dimensions are 12' wide x 15' deep. No trailers are allowed in the cook area. Teams will be allowed to unload trailers and then will be directed to the designated trailer parking area. This will be a parking lot 1 block west of the cook area. If you want to be by a specific team, please contact Trent (515.599.9011) after you have paid entry in and we will do our best to fill your request. Plan on no power being available. If you need power, please bring a small generator.

Meat

Meat is being provided by Bordenaro's Meat Market & Deli. Teams will be provided with the chicken and ribs for the contest as they check-in. Official meat hand out location will be at Bordenaro's Meat Market and Deli inside the "Old Alley Mall" on the east side of Adams street (see map for location). All contestants must follow basic food handling rules during the competition. Maintain 40 degrees or less prior to cooking, Chicken cooked to 165 minimum & Ribs cooked to 145 minimum.

Turn-In and Awards

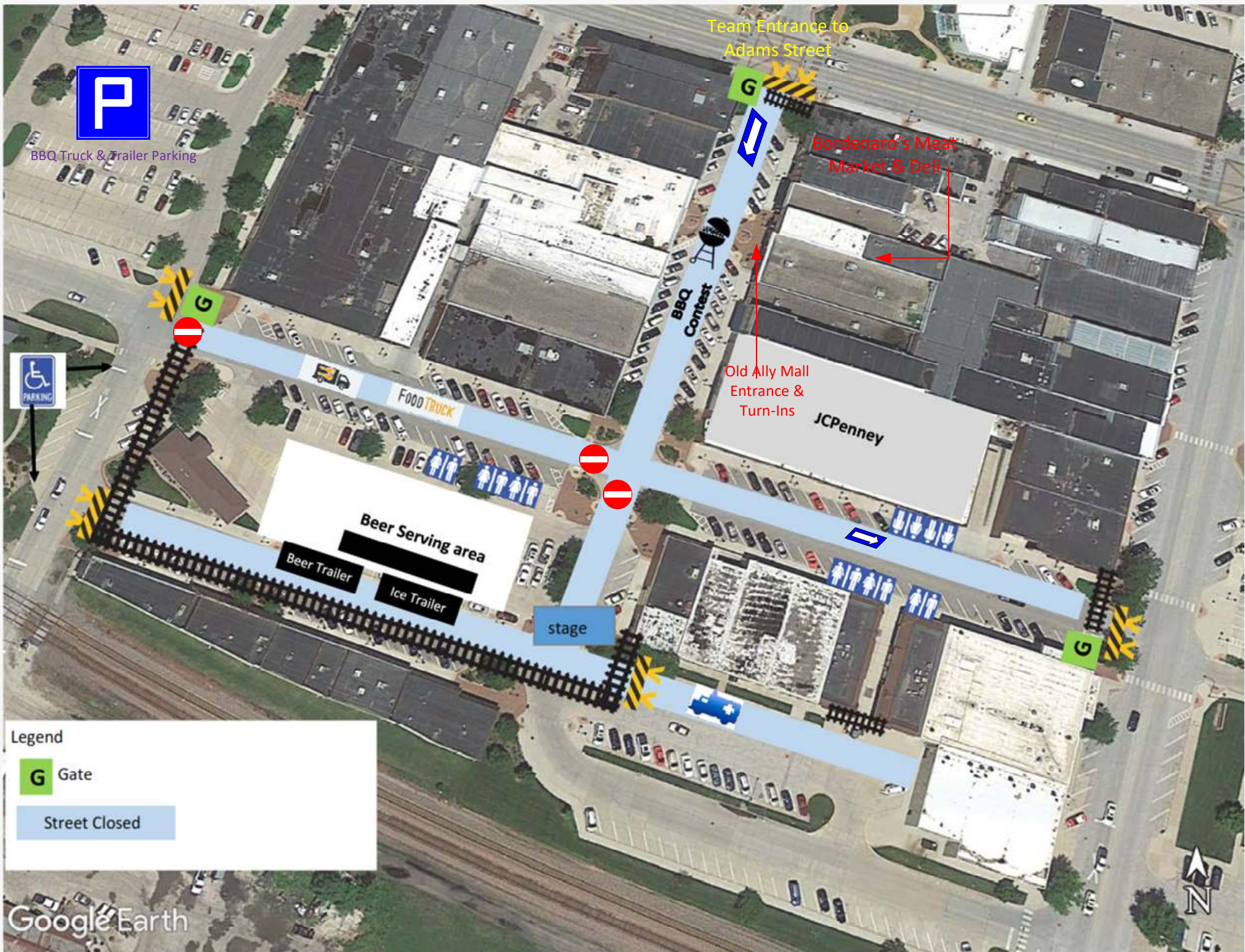
Teams will be provided 2 clam shells with a number on them at the cooks meeting. One is for Chicken and other for Ribs. There is to be NO GARNISH in the boxes, meat only. Boxes with garnish will receive a 1 for appearance score. Chicken turn-in will be at 4:00 pm, Rib turn-in will be at 4:30. There will be a designated area for teams to turn in their clam shell entries by the entrance to the "Old Alley Mall" (see map). Awards are planned for 5:30-6:00 pm on the main stage. This time may change to fit sound check and band schedules.

Site Cleanup

Each team will be responsible to leave their cooking area clean after the competition is complete. There will be waste, hot coal, and grease receptacles available for getting rid of each.
